

TOWN OF SURFSIDE CDL AND HEAVY EQUIPMENT OPERATOR

DEPARTMENT: PUBLIC WORKS

NON-EXEMPT

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

Performs a variety of equipment-based duties and act as the Town Heavy Equipment Operator capable of operating a large variety of heavy equipment. The position requires integration with all key Public Works Department operational divisions / functions which include but are not limited to utilities, maintenance, sanitation and fleet management.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- 1. Performs operational functions operating all heavy equipment such as, earth movers, back-hoe, skid steer, bulldozers, front-end loaders, and other related equipment.
- 2. Maintains and assists with the repair of heavy and power-driven equipment.
- 3. Performs road work, excavation work, lifting work, etc.
- 4. Performs minor repair works as needed.
- 5. Operates equipment manually and also through the use of electronic or technical methods of operation.
- 6. Works in adherence to safe practices, procedures, work site, traffic laws and any other applicable law.
- 7. Maintains and records daily activities, inventory chart, etc.
- 8. Reports to Operations Manager to be assigned to other Department duties as needed.
- Assist the fleet division with various assistance functions such as repairs, drop off of CDL vehicles and other.
- 10. Performs Solid Waste Operator duties, when requested.
- 11. May function in any emergency management role or capacity in the Incident Command System (ICS) to include, Logistics, Operations, and Planning.
- 12. Performs other duties as assigned

(These essential job functions are not to be construed as a complete statement of all duties performed. Employees will be required to perform other job-related marginal duties as required.)

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

KNOWLEDGE, ABILITIES AND SKILLS:

- Knowledge of the equipment, tools and supplies required to accomplish all operations.
- Ability to communicate and present information clearly, and to deal with the public relations in an effective, courteous, and tactful manner.

- Good customer service skills.
- Knowledge of heavy equipment principles and functions.
- Knowledge of properly loading heavy equipment for transport.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

High School Diploma, GED or equivalent; a minimum of 5 (five) years' experience in operating heavy equipment

(A comparable amount of training, education or experience can be substituted for the minimum qualifications.)

LICENSES, CERTIFICATIONS OR REGISTRATIONS:

Valid motor vehicle CDL license required

ESSENTIAL PHYSICAL SKILLS:

- Acceptable eyesight (with or without correction).
- Acceptable hearing (with or without hearing aid).
- Ability to communicate both orally and in writing.
- Heavy lifting and carrying (under 50 lbs.).
- Reaching.
- Pulling.
- Pushing.
- Walking.
- Standing.
- Kneeling.
- Bending.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS:

Work in an outside environment under various weather conditions
