

TOWN OF SURFSIDE MAINTENANCE WORKER II

DEPARTMENT: PUBLIC WORKS

NON-EXEMPT

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

Under general supervision performs a variety of semi-skilled maintenance, repair, or construction activities of routine difficulty throughout the Town. Work is assigned verbally and in writing. Work is reviewed through observation and written reports.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- Performs electrical maintenance both inside and outside Town Buildings, parking lots and streets to include time clock maintenance, street lights and lights both inside and outside of building
- 2. Performs asphalt/concrete maintenance/cleaning of Town sidewalks, parking lots, streets, etc.
 - Performs plumbing maintenance of all Town Buildings and grounds to include sprinkler checks and repairs.
- 3. Performs building maintenance inside and out to include dry wall repair, spackle, paint, framework, tile, ceilings and doors.
- 4. Performs light carpentry duties.
- 5. Maintains landscape of all public property.
- 6. Maintains, repairs, installs street signs and other public signs and traffic calming devices.
- 7. Repairs meters as needed.
- Washes Town vehicles as needed.
- 9. Works with the public.
- 10. Performs other duties as assigned.

(These essential job functions are not to be construed as a complete statement of all duties performed. Employees will be required to perform other job-related marginal duties as required.)

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

KNOWLEDGE, ABILITIES AND SKILLS:

- Knowledge principle of electrical and plumbing principles and practices of maintenance and repair of same.
- Knowledge of landscape and building maintenance and repair and ability to perform maintenance.
- Basic plans reading knowledge.
- Ability to understand and carry out oral and written instructions.
- Ability to perform strenuous work under a variety of weather conditions.

- Ability to maintain physical condition commensurate with demands of the position.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with co-workers and the general public.
- Skill in the use of a variety of equipment and machines required in utility and street maintenance and building repair work.
- Good customer service skills.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

High school diploma, GED, or equivalent certificate of competency; supplemented by two (2) years of experience in general construction, utilities maintenance, or related manual labor work; or an

equivalent combination of training and experience.

(A comparable amount of training, education or experience can be substituted for the minimum qualifications.)

LICENSES, CERTIFICATIONS, AND REGISTRATIONS:

Must possess a valid Florida Driver's License or may possess a Chauffeur's License depending upon the vehicle in use.

ESSENTIAL PHYSICAL SKILLS:

- Acceptable eyesight (with or without correction).
- Acceptable hearing (with or without hearing aid).
- Ability to communicate both orally and in writing.
- Moderate to heavy (over 15 pounds) lifting and carrying.
- Use of fingers, use of hands.
- Reaching, climbing, pulling, pushing.
- Walking, standing, kneeling, bending, crawling.
- Driving.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS:

- Works outside in various weather conditions including: noise, dust, chemicals, solvents, grease or oils, electrical energy, slippery surfaces.
- Works above and below ground level, in water.
- Heights.
