

TOWN OF SURFSIDE MECHANIC

DEPARTMENT: PUBLIC WORKS NON-EXEMPT

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

Skilled work in the general and major repair of cars, trucks and other Town equipment. Work is performed under general supervision of the Public Works Director.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- 1. Performs mechanical and service work on all Town vehicles including Police cars, trucks and other equipment such as: front ends; four-wheel brake job; tire replacement/repair; electrical repair; tune-ups; carburetors/fuel injection repairs; drive train repairs; diesel repair/minor/service, radiators, hydraulic hoses, cylinders, etc.
- 2. Picks up and delivers vehicles to various vendors. Drives and operates heavy equipment.
- 3. Repairs parts on vehicles and equipment.
- Checks Town gas storage tank.
- 6. Orders gasoline and other automotive supplies.
- Welds as needed.
- 8. Maintains various records.
- 9. Maintains generators for all Town facilities.
- 10. Performs other duties as assigned.

(These essential job functions are not to be construed as a complete statement of all duties performed. Employees will be required to perform other job-related marginal duties as required.)

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

KNOWLEDGE, ABILITIES AND SKILLS:

- Knowledge of construction, assembly, adjustment and maintenance of a wide variety of automotive, truck and other equipment.
- Knowledge of all types of shop tools involving automotive repair.
- Ability to follow directions and have a mechanical aptitude.
- Ability to repair gas and diesel motors and pumps.
- Ability to diagnosis the defects of worn or broken parts on engines.
- Ability to perform tune-ups; electrical, brake, minor air conditioning, cooling system, exhaust system repairs; front end and clutch repairs; pumps and related equipment maintenance.
- Skill in applying methods and techniques in the use of automotive or diesel repairs.
- Good customer service skills.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

High school graduation or possession of an acceptable equivalency diploma. At least ten (10) years mechanical experience in the automotive/truck repair field.

(A comparable amount of training, education or experience can be substituted for the minimum qualifications.)

LICENSES, CERTIFICATIONS OR REGISTRATIONS:

Must possess a valid Class "A" Florida Commercial Driver's License. A.S.E. Certified in the truck and automotive field.

ESSENTIAL PHYSICAL SKILLS:

- Acceptable eyesight (with or without correction).
- Acceptable hearing (with or without hearing aid).
- Heavy (45 pounds and over) lifting and carrying.
- Reaching.
- Climbing.
- Distinguish colors.
- Pulling.
- Pushing.
- Walking.
- Standing.
- Crawling.
- Kneeling.
- Bending.
- Balancing.
- Stooping.
- Driving.
- Equipment Operation.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS:

- Works inside.
- Works outside in various weather conditions with: noise, dust, fumes, grease or oils, electrical energy.
- Slippery surfaces.
- With moving objects or vehicles.
