Total crimes in Surfside decreased by 8.7% in 2012 (167) from 2011 (183). Aggravated Assaults increased from 2 to 12. Motor Vehicles Thefts increased from 4 to 9. Burglaries decreased from 26 to 23. Larcenies decreased from 149 to 120. Arrests increased from 141 to 211. The clearance rate also increased from 13.1% to 21.6% Great work!
