

### OFFICER OF THE MONTH-JULY 2015-OFFICER LESMES RUIZ

On July 27<sup>th</sup> at 0230 hours, Officer Ruiz pulled over a vehicle for a headlight out. Officer Ruiz immediately placed himself on the stop with the Municipal Dispatcher, advising his location, a vehicle description, and a tag number before exiting his vehicle. The dispatcher advised that the vehicle was stolen by Armed Carjacking from the City of Miami on 7/25/2015. Officer Ruiz remained by his vehicle and waited patiently while back up SPD officers responded in code 3 emergency mode arriving quickly as back up units. The driver who was the only occupant in the vehicle was taken off guard, taken out of the vehicle by Felony Traffic stop and placed in handcuffs. A records check also revealed that the subject was wanted for Petit Theft out of the City for Miami and that the vehicle had a Hold placed on it for latent prints because of the carjacking by the City of Miami Robbery Squad. Officer Ruiz received a Letter of Commendation for being proactive, acting quickly, professionally, and tactically taking a dangerous criminal into custody and off the streets without any incident. He was selected as the SPD July 2015 Officer of the Month.

### WATCH ORDERS/HOUSE CHECKS

When assigned to check a Watch Order / House Check officers shall advice the dispatcher of the location prior to exiting your vehicle. Generate an Event Number for each location. Officers are to carefully check the full perimeter of each location, front, back and sides, all doors and windows etc... Check vehicles left on the property are secured and undamaged.

Upon completing your check, document the findings in CAD notes and properly clear that location via the dispatcher. CAD note examples: "Perimeter checked QRU", "Found unlocked backdoor. House cleared, no sign of entry. Owner contacted. Door locked." If there is a broken window, damaged door or any noteworthy information generate a Case Number and document it accordingly (OIR, MIR of CAD note).

If for whatever reason you cannot check the full perimeter explain it in the CAD notes. For example, "6' locked Iron Gate prevented access to the backyard", "Large dog prevented access to back yard, front checked Qru." etc...

Reminder: Officer Safety is the first priority. For officers doing checks at night be cognizant of sprinklers, holes in the ground or low hanging tree branches as you walk in the dark.
