

RESOLUTION NO. 15 - 2315

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE, MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE LEVYING OF A MILLAGE RATE AGAINST ALL TAXABLE REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY IN THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE, FLORIDA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2015/2016; AND REAFFIRMING SEPTEMBER 21, 2015 AS THE DATE OF ADOPTION OF THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Commission of Surfside, Florida of Miami-Dade County finds it necessary to levy an ad valorem millage rate in the Town of Surfside, and

WHEREAS, on September 8, 2015 at 5:01 p.m., the Town Commission held a Public Hearing regarding such ad valorem millage rate as required by Florida Statute 200.65.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE, FLORIDA HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1. Recitals.** The above and foregoing recitals are true and correct.

**Section 2. Adoption of Tentative Millage.** The millage rate of 5.0293 mills is hereby adopted as the tentative millage rate for the Town of Surfside.

**Section 3. Comparative.** The tentative millage rate of 5.0293 mills is more than the rolled-back rate of 4.5400 mills as established by the State of Florida Truth in Millage (TRIM) of 10.78%.

**Section 4. Finalization of Millage.** A final public hearing shall be held on September 21, 2015 at 5:01 p.m. to adopt the final millage rate.


