D/B/A ALL **COUNTY** PAVING: TO MILL AND PAVE 88TH STREET EAST OF COLLINS AVENUE; AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER AND/OR DESIGNEE EXPEND FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$18,294.00 FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2015/2016 TRANSPORTATION FUND ACCOUNT NO. 107-8500-549-4911: **PROVIDING** FOR **AUTHORIZATION**; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; **PROVIDING** AN AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, access to 88th Street east of Collins was recently opened up to the hard pack for emergency access; and

WHEREAS, the road surface on 88th Street east of Collins Avenue, which is located in the public right of way, is in need of repair; and

WHEREAS, the Town received three bids (Attachment "A") for the restoration of the 88th Street east of Collins Avenue as follows:

- 1) M&M Asphalt Maintenance, Inc. d/b/a All County Paving \$18,294.00
- 2) Impact Site Development of Florida, LLC.

3) Marks Brothers, Inc.

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works recommends to award the proposal/contract to M&M Asphalt Company d/b/a All County Paving to mill and pave 88th Street east of Collins Avenue; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Town to award the proposal/contract to M&M Asphalt Maintenance, Inc. d/b/a All County Paving and to approve and authorize the expenditure of funds in the amount not to exceed \$18,294.00 from the Fiscal Year 2015/2016 Transportation Fund Account No. 107-8500-549-4911 for the restoration of the 88th Street.

As per directions to perform the following work: PREP WORK

- 1. Set up MOT (Barricades, Cones, Etc.).
- 2. Mill the entire section up to 1" average.
- Mill the existing asphalt in front of concrete tie-ins and asphalt roadways for smooth transition.
- Thoroughly clean off the existing surface prior to overlay.
- Haul away all debris.

ASPHALT PAVING: up to 5,420 S/F

- Tack areas with DOT approved primer tack.
- Install 1" hot plant mixed asphalt Type S-III.
- Roll and compact areas using a 3-5 ton steel drum and 9-wheel rubber tire roller.
- Clean and remove any related debris from site.

*As asphalt is a petroleum based product the prices are subject to change if oil prices increase dramatically.

*Existing Cracks with vegetation growing should be prepared with a weed killer such as 'Round Up' for several treatments before we arrive on the job

*The asphalt surface that will be placed on this project will not have the finish and look of a sealcoat application. If sealcoat is desired at a later date, we will be happy to quote you separately. *Large cracks in the existing asphalt may reflect through the new asphalt in time.

*There will be a tire 'tracking'-this cannot be avoided, but the tracking marks will disappear in time. *This proposal specifically excludes the acceptance of a "Pay when Paid Clause" payment clause.

*All County shall be provided with suitable access to the work area. If All County's work is dependent upon or must be undertaken in conjunction with the work of others, such work shall be performed and completed so as

to permit All County to perform its work hereunder in an uninterrupted single shift operation.

Delays to All County shall be paid at a rate of \$200.00 per half hour.

*In the event that any work is done under this agreement as amended, or any side agreement, by All County which work is on public property, the (Client/Owner) agrees and understands that the project property which it owns shall be charged with all indebtedness hereunder. *Any punch list items must be submitted in writing. No repairs will be made until 90% of the invoice amount has been paid.

*This contractor cannot guarantee elimination of standing water. *Job site will be barricaded during work. The contractor will not be responsible for persons breaking through barricades, tracking of materials or paint, damages to cars or persons trespassing in designated areas. Permit, Procurement fees and any additional work required by the permit will be extra to the contract amount.

There will be a charge of \$47.50 above the Contract amount to dispose of used

materials at an approved environmentally compliant waste facility.





Any additional reflective pavement markers that are required by the city code will be an additional charge of \$10.00 each to the contract amount. Any alteration or deviation from above specifications involving extra costs, will be executed only upon written orders, and will become an extra charge over and above the estimate. 


