

RESOLUTION NO. 22 - 2864

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE, FLORIDA CERTIFYING AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE GENERAL AND SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS HELD ON MARCH 15, 2022 FOR THE ELECTION OF MAYOR AND FOUR (4) TOWN COMMISSIONERS AND FIVE REFERENDUM/BALLOT QUESTIONS; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Surfside (“Town”) held a general municipal election on Tuesday, March 15, 2022, for the election of Mayor and four Commissioners of the Town of Surfside, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Surfside (“Town”) also held a special municipal election on Tuesday, March 15, 2022, for five referendum/ballot questions; and

WHEREAS, the qualifying period for the general election closed on January 29, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the deadline to submit the five referendum/ballot questions to the Miami-Dade County Supervisor of Elections was Friday, January 14, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Charles W. Burkett, Shlomo Danzinger and Tina Paul qualified to run for the Office of Mayor, and Shannon Gallagher, Fred Landsman, Marianne Meischheid, Jeffrey Rose, Eliana R. Salzhauer and Nelly Velasquez qualified to run for the Office of Town Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2021, the Town Commission adopted Resolutions No. 2021-2841 (General Obligation Bonds for undergrounding of utilities), Resolution No. 2021-2842 (Commission salaries and benefits), Resolution No. 2021-2844 (Prohibition on overnight storage on beach), Resolution No. 2022-2854 (Hedges in single-family residential lots), and Resolution No. 2022-2855 (Lot area building height), calling for a special election for the purpose of submitting to the electorate the proposed referendum/ballot questions; and

WHEREAS, the Miami-Dade County Canvassing Board has canvassed the returns, has tabulated the ballots of the mail in votes, and has determined the total number of votes at such election for the five referendum/ballot questions as shown by said returns; and

WHEREAS, the results of the March 15, 2022 Town General and Special Municipal Elections were certified on Friday, March 18, 2022 by the Miami-Dade County Supervisor of Elections, Christina White (Exhibit A” to the Resolution); and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission hereby certifies the election results of the March 15, 2022 Town General and Special Municipal Elections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals Adopted. The above and foregoing recitals are true and correct and are hereby adopted and incorporated herein.

Section 2. Certification of General and Special Elections. The Town Commission finds, declares and certifies the results of the General and Special Municipal Elections held on March 15, 2022 for the Office of the Mayor, the Office of the Town Commissioners and the five referendum/ballot questions pursuant to the Certificate of County Canvassing Board Miami-Dade County (See Exhibit “A” attached).

It is hereby certified and declared that pursuant to the votes cast in the General Municipal Election held on Tuesday, March 15, 2022, Shlomo Danzinger was duly elected Mayor, Jeffrey Rose was duly elected Vice Mayor and Fred Landsman, Marianne Meischeid and Nelly Velasquez were duly elected to the Town Commission for the term which shall commence at 8:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 16, 2022 and end on the third Wednesday in March 2024.

It is hereby certified and declared that pursuant to the votes cast in the Special Municipal Election held on Tuesday, March 15, 2022, the following results on the referendum/ballot questions are declared and certified:





CERTIFICATION OF ELECTION TABULATION

We, the undersigned, do by my signature hereto, certify that to the best of my knowledge:

1. On March 15, 2022, commencing at approximately 7:00 p.m., the Miami-Dade County Supervisor of Elections had the absentee ballot tabulating equipment tested to ascertain that the equipment will correctly count the votes cast for the candidates and/or issues, which have been voted in Surfside General Municipal and Special Elections, held on March 15, 2022.

2. The testing materials of the Public Test, delivered still under Seal No. 0000356, opened in my presence, were used and the procedures of Paragraph Two, Certification of Logic and Accuracy were followed.

3. At the completion of the above test all counters were zeroed, and all votes cast in the above election were counted. Steps have been taken to ensure the security of said materials prior to, during and subsequent to the election, except when said materials were properly in the possession of the Elections Department staff appointed to conduct the election.

4. Except as otherwise specifically set forth and declared in this certification, in our presence and sight, no absentee ballot was removed from or added, and no absentee ballot was in any manner altered or tampered with by any person, and no person touched any absentee ballot, except a person authorized to do so pursuant to Section 101.5612, Florida Statutes.

5. At the completion of the vote count, the absentee ballot tabulating equipment was again tested to ascertain that the equipment correctly counted the votes cast for the candidates and/or issues.
