9 10 11	WHEREAS, the Town of Surfside ("Town") Commission wishes to amend Chapter 86 of the Town's Code of Ordinances to repeal Section 86-1 which prohibits the use of surfboards in any area in the Town not specifically designated for such sport by posted signs; and

14 15	NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE HEREBY ORDAINS:1
16 17	<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Recitals.</u> The above-stated recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.
18 19	Section 2. Town Code Amended. The Code of the Town of Surfside, Florida is hereby amended by repealing Section 86-1 in its entirety as follows:

21	Article I. – IN GENERAL

23	Sec. 86-1 Surfboards.
24 25 26 27 28	(a) Legislative findings. The town commission does make a legislative determination and finding that the uncontrolled use of surfboards in the town has resulted in serious injury to persons and property; that, if not controlled, additional injury to persons and property will result; and, that the public health, welfare and safety require that regulations be implemented to control surfboarding and prevent additional injury to persons and property.
29 30	(b) Use prohibited. The use of surfboards is prohibited in any area in the town not specifically designated for such sport by posted signs.

31 32	(c) Penalty for violation. Any person violating any of the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished as provided in section 1-8.
33 34 35 36 37	Section 3. Codification. It is the intent of the Town Commission that the provisions of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Town's Code of Ordinances, and that the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered, and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," "regulation," or such other appropriate word or phrase in order to accomplish such intentions.
38 39 40 41 42 43	Section 4. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance but they shall remain in effect, it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.
44 45	Section 5. Conflicts. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, resolutions or parts of resolutions, in conflict herewith, are repealed to the extent of such conflict.
46 47	Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption on second reading.
