Below is a weekly overview of key administration activities per department for the week of January 9, 2023:

# **Building Department**

- The Building Department has cleared out 3 large storage units of all permits and plans going back as far as 1935. These historical documents are now in the hands of GRM Document Management, Inc., who is tasked with storing and scanning these important documents. This result is an immediate savings of \$25,470.00 annually and sets the stage for future online web-based digital document access.
