

Town Manager's Message

By the time you read this, we will be in 2012. On behalf of the Town Commission and the employees please accept our best wishes for a happy and healthy New Year. Following are my main New Year's Resolutions:

- 1 Continue to manage this community in an efficient and effective manner with full transparency encouraging citizen involvement.
- 2) Complete the Water/Sewer/Storm Drainage project quickly and with minimal disruption.
- 3) Expand programming in the Community Center with particular emphasis on cultural events and more activities for teens.
- 4) Expand the Five Year Financial and Strategic Plan to ensure that we continue to build reserves in all funds.
- 5) Implement the Downtown Vision Advisory Committee recommendations after full community and Town Commission discussion while making sure that character of Surfside remains in its laid back family state.
- 6) Ensure that the repaying by FDOT of the Collins and Harding corridors minimizes traffic impact.
- 7) Upgrade the hard pack, walking path, beach and dune maintenance.
- 8) Review modernization of our solid waste and recycling programs to achieve a reasonable level of service in an efficient manner comparable to similar beachside communities.
- 9) Watch the details like landscape maintenance, feral cat and dog issues, refinishing parking lots, new entry and parking locator signs for the community, code enforcement, community garden, keeping our technology up to date including electronic payment of utility and other bills and converting records to electronic access.
- 10) Work with the Town Attorney and the Town Commission to settle or win several contentious and expensive lawsuits.
- 11) Developing staff through training and mentoring.
- 12) Work with the Planning and Zoning/Design Review Boards to improve the quality and impact of new construction.
- 13) Lose 25 pounds by year's end.

Commission Action for December 2011

- Approving a waiver of the requirements for a six foot setback and accompanying landscaping for a temporary construction fence along Harding Avenue for the property owner of 9585 Harding Avenue.
- Approved an expanded progam of activities at the Community Center.
- Authorized the Town Manager to prepare a Request for Proposals for a parking structure feasibility sudy n the Abbot Parking lot.
- Authorizing the Manager of the Town of Surfside to execute an agreement with the Miami Dade State Attorney's Office to prosecute criminal municipal ordinance violations in Surfside.
- Authorizing the Town to enter into an agreement with Luke's Landscape piggybacking off the competively bid contract awarded by the City of Aventura, saving \$12,000 annually and improving the quality of service.
- •A resolution providing for a uniform method of collecting non-ad valorem assessments for recycling services and solid waste services. Next year, these costs will appear on your annual tax bill.
- A resolution adopting a cost recovery consultant fee schedule to be escrowed and maintained for purposes of reimbursing the Town for consultant fees incurred.
- A resolution proclaiming support and approving a \$500 contribution for the Children's Movement of Florida.
- A resolution abolishing the Town of Surfside Beautification Committee and expressing appreciation for the efforts of the members who served.


