

# Message from the Town Manager

First and foremost...congratulations to Mayor Daniel Dietch, Vice Mayor Michael Karukin and Commissioners Marta Olchyk and Shelly Lisbon for their election to the 2012-14 Town Commission. We also look forward to filling the remaining open seat during a special election to be held May 1, 2012. The first Town Commission meeting with Shelly Lisbon on the dais will be April 10, 2012 and the first meeting with a full Commission will be May 8, 2012. Thanks also to former Vice Mayor Joe Graubart and Commissioner Ted Kopelman for their service.

There has been much discussion regarding why no one stood to qualify for the vacant Town Commission seat. Please consider the following possibilities: The incumbent Town Commission did a good job. Deliberations were civil, financial transparency was enhanced, money was spent wisely and the Town looks better than it has in years. Staff responsiveness to citizen inquiries is rapid and polite, millage and actual tax bills were lowered for most residents, we held the line of water/sewer/ solid waste and storm drainage charges and the new Community Center has been a transformational project for the Town.

On the other hand, some residents think that the direction the Town is taking is incorrect and have stated publicly that the reason no one stood to qualify is that "folks have given up" and believe that it is a "waste of time" to try to return the Town to the "good old days." They rely on the difficulties of modern life, the stresses of four years of recession and the fear of reprisal for standing up to oppose a majority position. They also ignore the concern about being attacked in the blogs and the impact on your family when these folks call you corrupt and uncaring in the new forms of unaccountable communication that our electronic age has created.

However you feel about the current state of affairs in Surfside, it is important to come out to vote to make your feelings known. We do have a small slice of paradise here and it needs to be protected and enhanced in a very careful manner. Whether you think the glass is half empty of half full is an argument with no end. What is important is where the glass started. Two years ago, the glass was empty and the leadership of the Town Commission filled it way past the halfway mark. Maybe that is why we have a vacancy...because most folks are happy with the Town and its leadership. Let's fill the vacant seat and keep filling the glass.

# DecoBikes Rolling Into Surfside

DecoBike will soon launch its popular bike sharing program in Surfside. The company operates a public "bike sharing" program, a new form of alternative public transportation touted for its environmental benefits and ability to save time and money for its riders. With the success of the bike sharing program in Miami Beach, Surfside began exploring ways to bring the benefits to the Town's residents and visitors.



DecoBike Surfside will link to the Miami Beach system, which has as many as 100,000 riders per month. The Miami Beach program received the prestigious U.S.

Conference of Mayors City Livability award. The rugged and customized "beach cruiser" style DecoBikes are equipped with self-powered LED lights for riding in dark conditions, a convenient basket for groceries or a laptop, an adjustable "comfort" sea and other unique features.

The program allows a rider to check out a bike from two stations in Surfside (Town Hall and Publix) and return it to any other station, 24/7. Handy smart phone apps and their website make it easy to locate stations and available bikes. Station coverage areas includes major grocery stores, condominiums, commercial centers, banks, shops, restaurants, beaches and parks – making it easy to "kiss your car goodbye." It takes only seconds to check out a bike and rentals are geared towards visitors and those seeking a bike to get to where they need to go. Many use DecoBikes instead of waiting on a cab or bus, while others just want to take a leisurely cruise along the beach. Rentals range from 30 minutes to 24 hours.


