

Message from the Town Manager

This Manager's message will catch you up on a number of current topics.

First, the water/sewer/storm drainage project is nearly 57 percent complete. The second phase of the project which is very close to completion included the complicated storm drainage improvement. The initial repaving of the entire second phase should be done by July 15, 2012 if the weather allows. The third phase of the entire project from 93rd Street north will begin during the first week of July, 2012. Our initial focus will be the work on Byron Avenue south of 96th Street to complete this high traffic element of the project before school reopens.

Second, Staff has been approached by the developers of the Best Western and Surf Club sites. Both projects will undergo intense scrutiny during the Development Impact Committee process as well as the Planning and Zoning Board and Town Commission processes. The entire review is open to the public and televised. You are strongly urged to participate.

Third, there will be a Special Election on August 28, 2012 to fill the Commission vacancy created by Shelly Lisbon's decision to run for the Florida House of Representatives District 100 seat which was created by the redistricting required after every 10 year U.S. Census. The qualifying period is July 5, 2012 through July 24, 2012. Contact Town Clerk Sandra Novoa if you are interested in running for a seat on the Surfside Town Commission. She will provide the necessary paperwork.

Fourth, the Town Commission has placed four Charter Reform items on the November 2012 election ballot. These include a Citizen's Bill of Rights, clarification of election procedures when a vacancy occurs, clarification of the height, density, floor, area and ratio limitation for buildings in the Charter and the requirement that the entire Charter be reviewed in the next year and every ten years after that. Look for much more information about these changes over the summer and early fall prior to the election.

Fifth, a few kudos are in order. Officer Tammy Campbell has been named Miami Dade County Officer of the month for her recent arrest of a bank robber in downtown Surfside, appreciation to our recruitment consultant Colin Baenziger for his support in recruiting our new Finance Director Donald Nelson who had a long career as the Finance Director of Coral Gables, Commissioner Kligman who

Community Center Being Considered for Awards

The Town of Surfside Community Center has more than its one-year anniversary to celebrate. It is also in the running for two prestigious awards. Through an application from the Parks and Recreation Department, the Community Center is being considered for an Agency Excellence Award through the Florida Recreation and Parks Association. It is also nominated for the City Spirit Award through the Florida League of Cities. Both of these awards focus on addressing local needs and the completion of the Community Center. Award announcements are expected in July.

Surfside's Feral Cat Program



A group of concerned Surfside residents and volunteers have begun an effort to trap feral cats to be spayed or neutered. The cats are vaccinated and their ears "tipped" for future identification and rescued kittens are then available for adoption.

As a result, the Surfside beach cat population has fallen dramatically. Only

Town-authorized volunteers are permitted to feed the feral cats and monitor their health and numbers. The program has been expanded throughout the town and the rewards are already clear as fewer and fewer cats roam our streets. PetSmart Charities awarded a grant with the sole purpose of expanding our TNR (Trap, Neuter and Release) program and to prevent 250 free-roaming cats from reproducing. Please note:

- Our volunteers rely on residents to alert them of strays. We encourage you to become a volunteer by contacting Dina Goldstein in the Police Department for more information: (305)861-4862. You will become a "Certified Surfside TNR Volunteer" through your participation in this program.
- Domestic or pet cats should also be spayed/ neutered if allowed to roam freely to insure that the program is effective. Pet cats' ears will not be "tipped," but should wear identification to indicate they are not strays.
- The Code Compliance Director enforces the cat feeding program. Fines will be imposed violating public health concerns for leaving cat food outside unattended and for littering. Note that it is also illegal to abandon cats or kittens in Surfside.

Accreditation Team Invites Public to Comment on the Police Department

A team of assessors from the Commission for Florida Law Enforcement Accreditation (CFA) will visit the Surfside Police Department on August 1-3, 2012 to examine all aspects of the Department's policies and procedures, management, operations and support services. The Department must comply with approximately 260 standards to achieve reaccreditation.

Listen to the Girl With a Thousand and One Songs

Many long-time Surfsiders will fondly remember Hazel Lee, who put on holiday shows for many years at the previous Town Community Center. Known as the "Girl With a Thousand and One Songs," a lifetime as a singer and performer has treated her well. She is still entertaining at the age of 91!

With an accompanying guitarist, she still regularly gives one hour shows at retirement facilities and nursing homes, enriching the lives of many with her talent and music. Lee moved to South Florida in 1958 and has lived in Surfside since the 1970s. In the 1960s she was well-known as a "torch" singer, cocktail drummer and night club owner during the hey-day of Miami nightlife. She



owned and entertained at Lee's Lounge in the Gibson Hotel on 79th Street and later Lee's 340. She continues to specialize in classic popular songs.

When she was in her twenties, Lee made a different kind of music: with a rivet gun. Her husband was stationed at a U.S. Army air base in Dalhart, Texas during WW II. For three years, Lee

worked as a machinist's assistant at an airplane factory. She is still a member of the Rosie the Riveter Association.

Lee has two children who continue to work, even though they are past retirement age. She has six grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren. She wears a necklace with a charm for each one.

One of her secrets of longevity is that she swims laps nearly every day for exercise. But she is the first to admit that it is her singing and music that keeps her young at heart!


Teens Enjoy Summer Camp With Police


