Message from the Town Manager

The Summer doldrums have by passed Surfside. There is activity everywhere. The water/ sewer/storm drainage project is now more than 60 percent complete. Our recent focus has been to complete the drainage project below 93rd Street to 88th Street along Bay Drive. The residents of this area have had to undergo the most complex and long lasting element of the project. The pumps and drainage structures are nearly complete and new curb/gutter and first lift (course) of asphalt have been installed. For those of you who were concerned when we had nearly 12 inches of rain in three days with most of the rain coming at high tide, please rest assured that the new system is working even without the pumps completed. What most people saw was ponding in the road because the one inch reveal where the asphalt meets the concrete gutter is necessary until the final lift (wearing course) is laid. This step will be done town wide when all other construction is complete. This helps to ensure that the final smooth lift of asphalt is uniform and undamaged town wide. We have begun Phase 3 of the project which is the new water lines and sewer replacement/ repair from 93rd Street north to the Town limits. Our focus will be to complete the north end of Byron Avenue before school starts. This is a traffic choke point that is very frustrating to our residents and the folks who live on Byron Avenue. We are working with Miami Dade County to improve the timing of the traffic signal to let more cars turn on to 96th Street and not get stopped at the light for the entrance to the Bal Harbour Shops parking facility.

Moving on, the Public Works and Parking Departments have completed the renovation of the 93rd Street, Town Hall East/Recreation Center and Shul parking lots. Kudos for a job well done and a terrific upgrade. The new signage should go in within six weeks which will demonstrate a fresh new image for Surfside. These projects are funded with parking revenues and use no property taxes. The remaining three lots are on hold until the parking structure feasibility study is complete. This study will allow a decision to be made by the Town Commission based on independent rational and professional analysis. Please respond to the surveys that will be included in the next issue so that your thoughts regarding downtown parking can be included in the data base.

The preliminary report regarding the seawall conditions at all the street ends in Surfside and Surfside Park has been received. The results are not good. Some seawalls are in very poor condition and others need work to ensure their continued life. The report will be discussed by the Town Commission in their August 15, 2012 meeting. The Administration's recommendation will be to accept the report and authorize us to apply to the Florida Inland Navigation District for a grant to help with the cost of repairing the seawalls. Check your property tax bill and you will see that a small millage is assessed by this agency. Perhaps we can get some of it back. We also plan to have an element of the project bidding to be unit prices to repair private seawalls. This cost will be borne by the property owners. However, the per foot cost will be a fraction of the individual lot repairs because the mobilization cost will be spread throughout the Town. More to follow on this project.

The FY 12/13 Budget process is well underway. The Town Commission has met in a work shop and a Special Meeting environment to give direction to the Administration. Right now, the

Town Parking Study Underway

The Town is working with the consulting group Rich & Associates to conduct a Parking Structure Feasibility Study for the Town. This firm is presently reviewing the parking availability and usage around the Harding Avenue business district and Town Hall.

Part of the study includes conducting surveys of Surfside residents, visitors, business operators, business employees and downtown property owners. Surfside residents will have the opportunity to submit their views by completing a survey that will accompany the September Gazette. There will also be opportunities to participate in this study by attending two public hearings which will be scheduled for this Fall. proposed millage will be reduced to 5.4000 mills from 5.5000 mills. Staff have been directed by the Town Commission to analyze lowering the millage further to 5.0635 which will require \$417,000 in additional reductions or new non property tax revenues. There will be a Special Meeting of the Town Commission on August 23, 2012 at 4 pm to review the potential for achieving this lowered millage from the proposed 5.4000 mills and to review nine Summer Studies that provide detailed information on subjects such as building a dog park to revising how often and the methodology we use for collecting solid waste in the single family neighborhood. Please remember that your notice of proposed taxes will be mailed in late August, 2012. For the first time, this notice will contain your solid waste and recycling cost in the annual amount of \$277.08. Once you get the notice, come to the Special Meeting and two public hearings to be held September 10 and 24 at 5 pm in Town Hall.

We have a Special Election scheduled for August 28, 2012 to replace Commissioner Lisbon who is running for the State House of Representatives. As of this writing, three candidates have either qualified or have submitted signatures for verification by the Supervisor of Elections. It is extremely important that you vote. We are working with the League of Women Voters to schedule a candidate forum in the week before the election. Questions will be accepted in writing up to 30 minutes before the event and the League will determine which questions are asked of the candidates. There will also be three Town Charter Amendments on the ballot for the November 6, 2012 election. These questions will be explained in much more factual and value neutral detail in subsequent editions of the *Gazette*.

There is so much more to talk about, however, we have run out of space. Look for information about the Best Western, Surf Club and Shul projects which are all beginning their journey through the development review process; the potential second story on the Community Center and the undergrounding of utilities Town wide in future issues. Our efforts to attract a national tenant to the downtown area may soon come to fruition and the construction necessary to close Byron Avenue to northbound traffic at 88th Street will begin very soon. This will be a game changer for the quality of life in the single family neighborhood. Finally, the FDOT repaving of Collins and Harding Avenues is ahead of schedule. We have had some monumental traffic jams as predicted. To judge from the complaint level, some of the jams go as far north as Jacksonville. Thanks for your patience and understanding.

One last item. Remember to vote on August 14, 2012 (Primary and County Election for Mayor) and August 28, 2012 for the Special Town elelction. While I do not usually comment on ballot issues, there is a very deceptive and dangerous item on the August 14, 2012 ballot. The item relating to regulating pit bulls – if approved – would actually cease regulating these potentially very dangerous animals. Read it carefully. We do not need to have unregulated pit bulls in Surfside.

Surfside Officers Capture Bank Robber

While on patrol in the 9500 block of Abbott Avenue, Officer Tammy Campbell was notified by a witness that a man just robbed the Amtrust Bank. She pursued the suspect on foot to the Abbott parking lot where he entered his vehicle. She called for assistance while holding the suspect at gunpoint. Sqt. Jay Matelis arrived and removed the suspect from the car and handcuffed him. The robber was arrested and the money recovered. The man had been sought by the FBI for other bank robberies. Both officers received Officer of the Month honors.

Officer Jonathan Alvarez was patrolling an area where there had been a number of bikes stolen and saw a suspicious person riding a bike and wearing a backpack. Stanley Flax Inspires Others with Creativity



It was a third grade teacher that taught Stanley Flax that using your imagination was a perfectly good way to learn. Kittens available for adoption



As part of the Town's PetsMart Charities Grant, kittens that have been neutered, have received all their shots and are litterbox trained are available for adoption.

The Grant provides equipment and supplies for improving the quality of life in

our community for both humans and animals. With the cooperation of concerned residents, the Town's efforts to reduce its population of free roaming cats is proving successful as the program expands throughout the town. It includes trapping cats and kittens for medical attention, neutering and, in some cases, adoption. It is important to alert the town of any free-roaming cats or kittens that do not have a "marked or tipped left ear," which signifies a feline has been neutered. Residents who regularly feed free-roaming cats should make sure volunteers are able to trap in that specific location. Do not leave animal food overnight and feed only on your own property not on sidewalks or in public sight in accordance with Town Code. Feeding cats on public property is allowed only with Town authorization.

The program is seeking teens who need community service credits, professionals who can volunteer or contribute their services or supplies and adults who can trap, foster or help with adoption efforts.
