

Message from the Town Manager

Seems like every month my message says "what a month this has been." Once again this is true for August. Let's start with our near miss with Tropical Storm Isaac. In three days we experienced more than 12 inches of rain with one band that dropped three inches in two hours. The partially completed new storm drainage system performed wonderfully. Within a few hours the ponding was gone. When the system is completed, the water will be removed very quickly and will be much cleaner if very heavy rains require pumping into the Bay. More importantly, your Town Emergency Team led by Chief David Allen responded in a magnificent manner. From preparation for the storm to clean-up the Police, Public Works, Park and Recreation, Solid Waste and Code Compliance staff all did a terrific job. They were there when we needed them often putting their own family protection second to the Town needs.

Our various capital projects are moving along. The water/sewer/storm drainage project is more than 68 percent complete. The contractor Ric Man worked 12 hour days to complete Byron Avenue between 95th and 96th Streets before school opened. Miami Dade County adjusted the traffic signals to allow 10 seconds more time for cars to proceed to 96th Street. During the first week of school these changes corrected a frustrating traffic situation. Again, congrats to our Public Works and Police Departments for getting this done. The repaving of Collins and Harding Avenues is also moving along with the second course of asphalt scheduled for completion by the end of September 2012. Once this is done, the new stamped asphalt crosswalks, signage, bike path, striping and remaining sidewalk repairs will be completed with the whole job being past us by the end of the year. Thanks for your patience with this very difficult and frustrating traffic management situation.

The Town Commission also held its second FY 12/13 Budget Special Meeting. The FY 10/11 Budget set the millage rate at 5.6030 mills or \$5.60 per thousand of non- exempt valuation. The FY 11/12 Budget reduced the millage rate to 5.5000 and the Proposed FY 12/13 Budget further reduced the millage rate to 5.4000. The Town Commission reviewed the proposed rate and determined to lower it more to 5.3000 requiring a combination of non-property tax revenue adjustments and expenditure reductions of slightly more than \$120,000. In two years, the millage rate has been reduced by 5.9 percent. The impact in real dollars depends on many factors including your assessment and exemptions. Remember that this year's Notice of Proposed Property Taxes includes the solid waste and recycling fees.

Turtles Hatch on Surfside Beach

On August 6, 2012 a leatherback sea turtle nest

hatched in Surfside and 49 baby leatherbacks made their way into the ocean under the safety of darkness. There were a total of fifty nine eggs in the nest. Two straggling turtles were found alive in the nest in the morning and were taken to officials from the Miami Dade Sea Turtle Program. They were monitored and were



released after regaining their strength. There have been approximately 16 nests in Surfside this season, and this was the only leatherback nest. The rare and endangered leatherback is the largest turtle on earth. Turtle season continues until October 31.

Surfside Resident is the King of Latin Soft Drinks

Cawy Lemon Lime, Jupiña, Materva, Malta ... most South Florida residents are familiar with the family of these

and other Miami-made fruit-flavored soft drinks under the Cawy brand. But few know the Surfside businessman whose 70-year legacy of hard work was responsible for bringing the popular drinks to the U.S.

Frank Garcia, a Surfside resident for nearly 30 years, celebrates his 90th birthday this month. Frank Garcia and his partners founded the Cawy Bottling Company in 1967 in Miami, reviving and expanding a nostalgic

brand that was originally founded in 1948

Cuba. The Cuba-based soft drink company was seized by the Castro government in the early 1960s and ceased operation.
Frank, who immigrated to the U.S. in 1953, partnered with Celestino Villaba and Vincente Cossio to register the soft drink brands and invest in creating the Cawy bottling plant. Cossio had the original formula for the Materva drink from Cuba.

"We started the company knowing many people in South Florida would remember these soft drinks from Cuba," Frank said. "We

were the only ones who made these fruit flavors and the business grew."

Today, after 45 years, Cawy remains a successful family-owned business. It is still located in its original Allapatah neighborhood, providing jobs and a unique group of products popular both in our region and internationally.

Frank was born in 1922 in the small town of Nazareno, Cuba. With the premature death of his father, Frank was raised by his uncle, Porfirio, and his family. A natural-born entrepreneur and hard worker, he showed promise at an

early age. He came to the U.S. to attend college and learn English at the University of Alabama. He stayed to pursue business opportunities. He settled in Hoboken, New Jersey, purchasing

a laundry and a bodega. Here, he met his business partner and life-long friend Celestino Villaba. Before coming to Miami, they built Villaba & Garcia, a successful grocery distribution company serving four states in the Northeast.

Once the partners established the Cawy Bottling Company, the families moved to Miami. Frank has been married to his wife, Edith, for 56 years. They raised three boys: the late Frankie, John and Alex. Frank also has a daughter, Silvia, from his first marriage.

Frank and Edith have lived in Surfside for nearly 30 years. "Surfside is the greatest place in the world!" Frank said. "We have the best view." With a large group of grandchildren, their Marbella Condominium home is family central for holidays and gatherings.


11th Surfside Citizens Police Academy Begins Sept. 20

Dogs weighing up to 40 pounds will be sterilized and vaccinated against rabies if needed. Dogs weighing in excess of 40 pounds are not eligible for surgery. Veterinarians may decline surgery of any pet due to health reasons. Resident ID Card Renewal Begins Oct. 1

Surfside will begin renewing resident identification cards on October 1, 2012 for the upcoming fiscal year (October to September 30, 2013). The renewal process will take place at the Community Center during business hours 9 am – 6 pm, every day. Here are the guidelines for renewing the identification cards:

- Bring current ID cards
- If you are a homeowner, bring one of the following:
 - -Current Utility Bill
 - -Current Bank Statement
 - -Current Credit Card Statement
- If you are a renter, bring a copy of the lease that includes the dates of rental and people authorized to reside.
- If you are a renter without a valid lease, you must fill out the Temporary Community Center Access Form in person and have it notarized.
 - Resident ID Cards are limited to one family per address.
- There will be a \$5 charge for lost, stolen or replacement cards.
 - ID Cards are issued to children 5 years and older.
 - Parental proof may be required for ages 5-17.
